Introduction:

The Young Scientist Award was established to recognize pioneering achievements in scientific and/or technological activities performed by individual young scientists. The evaluation process involves a careful consideration of each award candidate's future potential based on their work. It is aimed to encourage young scientists to perform further exciting research in the relevant field and contribute to a successful career for the award recipients. This international prize will be awarded for outstanding results as submitted to 2020 International Topical Meeting on Microwave Photonics (MWP2020).

Rules of Eligibility:

Applicants must have been

- ✓ the IEEE member by the end of the MWP2020 period,
- \checkmark under the age of 35 in November 2020, and
- ✓ the first and corresponding author of the paper submitted to the MWP2020.

Selection Method:

A review committee will be set up under the MWP2020 Technical Program Committee and MWP2020 Local Organization Committee to carry out a rigorous review process. A number of committee members shall set up to 10 including the committee chair.

Note:

The award shall be granted a commendation certificate and trophy and award money. Award money shall be JPY50,000.
